

Affordable housing programs that serve some of the most vulnerable members of our community are under attack.

The Trump Administration is proposing to eliminate or deeply cut programs that provide rental assistance to low income families and seniors, repairs to public housing, and basic community services. At the same time, the Administration is proposing billions in tax cuts to corporations and the most wealthy.

Meanwhile San Francisco is considering a proposal by Supervisors Safai, Breed, and Tang that will raise rents and cut the percentage of affordable housing units that developers are required to include in new projects from 25% to 18%. This proposal is being presented as a 'win' for middle income workers because it imposes all the cuts on lower income workers and families. But the real winners are real estate developers: more than \$60 million annually in rent hikes and reduced affordable housing obligations at today's development levels.

Our communities need to unite to fight the cuts to all working people and the poor. We need action and policies that protect all tenants and working people.

- No federal or City cuts to affordable housing
- Stop giveaways to developers and tax breaks to corporations
- Reject policies that pit the middle class against the most vulnerable
- Strengthen tenant protections for all San Franciscans
