Below is a short list of programs that will be reduced or eliminated by the Mayor's budget.

Outpatient substance abuse 1-1 therapy, Youth violence and substance abuse prevention, In school, after school, and summer programs, Crisis Clinics, Same day treatment for psychiatric medications and treatment to prevent the need for higher levels of care, Youth jail diversion programs, Youth shelter for abused kids (Huckleberry House), Supportive housing programs, LGBT services, Senior programs, Adult day care, AIDS programs, Supportive Housing Rent Subsidies for AIDS housing, SRO tenant organizing & code enforcement, Mental health and 1-1 counseling, MAP program which helps and transports homeless people in crisis (a much needed program that saves a lot of money), Supportive programs for formerly homeless children and families, Food programs for needy seniors, Methadone programs, and so on and so on.
