


Jobs With Justice | San Francisco

Founded in 2010, Jobs with Justice San Francisco sees that the struggles that workers face at the worksite are inseparable from the struggles workers face in their communities. We participate in nationally coordinated activities and support JwJ coalitions in other parts of the country.

Our current priorities include supporting immigrant and other low wage workers, campaigning for progressive revenue to protect public services and jobs, improving public education, creating good jobs in the healthcare, retail and other strategic sectors and fighting corporate greed at Walmart, Hyatt and Sutter CPMC.
